ASSISTANCE FOR RESIDENTS OF SOMERSET

South East Queensland Rainfall & Flooding, 22-28 February 2022

Activated locations: Somerset Local Government Area.

If you are experiencing personal hardship or require emotional support as a result of the South East Queensland Rainfall and Flooding event, assistance is available. You may be eligible for financial or other assistance to help you get back on your feet.

When completing grant applications online, please ensure your personal details are entered exactly as they appear on your driver's licence (e.g. spelling of your name) and Medicare card. If you have dependents, list them in order as stated on your card.

Commonwealth / State Grants

Emergency Hardship Assistance

\$180 per person (up to \$900 for a family of five or more) for people who are unable to meet their immediate essential needs for temporary accommodation, food, essential clothing and medication. It can take up to five days for payments to reach your bank account.

Essential Services Hardship Assistance

\$150 per person (up to \$750 for a family of five or more) for people who have experienced the loss of one or more essential services for more than five days.

Essential Household Contents Grant *

One-off payment for households who are uninsured or unable to claim insurance as a contribution towards replacing or repairing essential household contents. Up to \$1,765 for single adults and up to \$5,300 for couples/families.

Structural Assistance Grant *

One-off payment towards the cost of repairs to uninsured, owner-occupied homes to ensure the home is habitable, secure and safe. Up to \$10,995 for single adults and up to \$14,685 for couples/families.

Services available at a hub include:

- Psychological, emotional, and personal support including counselling
- Financial and practical assistance
- Housing support
- Information to support clean up and recovery: Flood-specific information about safe clean up, managing health concerns, and how to cope
- Information and referral to nongovernment organisations and

To help owner/occupied households reconnect essential services that were damaged by a disaster. Up to \$200 towards a safety inspection for each essential service needing reconnection (electricity, gas, water and sewerage or septic system) and up to \$4,200 towards repair work.

* Income Test

Weekly income must be less than:

- individual: \$988 (\$51,398 per year)
- couple: \$1,367 (\$71,061 per year)
- sole parent, one child: \$1,368 (\$71,110 per year)
- couple, one child: \$1,694 (\$88,111 per year).

For each additional child add a further \$327 per week; for each dependent adult add \$378 per week.
