

Participating in this competition constitutes an acceptance of these Terms and Conditions:

1. To be eligible to enter the competition, participants must:
 - a) Be a Somerset resident
 - b) Fully complete and submit the online Somerset Libraries feedback survey form available at somerset.qld.gov.au/library between 9am (AEST) on Monday, 20 May 2019 and 11.59pm (AEST) on Sunday, 25 August 2019.
2. Only one entry is permitted per person. A person must not submit multiple entries.
3. No responsibility is accepted for late, lost or misdirected entries. All entries become the property of Somerset Regional Council.
4. Incomplete, undecipherable or ineligible entry forms will be deemed invalid.
5. There will be three prizes and one winner of each prize.
6. Council reserves the right, at any time, to verify the validity of entries and entrants and to disqualify any entrant who submits an entry that is not in accordance with these Terms and Conditions.
