Application for operation of a low-impact temporary entertainment event – where 2,000 people or more. A “low impact temporary entertainment event” is one where the event does not meet the definition of a high impact event as below	\$855.00
Application for operation of a high-impact temporary entertainment event – where 2,000 people or more. A “high impact temporary entertainment event” is one where the applicant or promoter is a for-profit entity and where the event includes amplified music to be played after 8:30pm over two or more nights.	\$5,000.00
Administration surcharge - peer review charge (where Council engages a suitably qualified consultant to conduct a peer review of professional reports forming part of the application) where 2,000 or more people will attend the event.	At cost
