

Dog Desexing Promotion

Somerset Regional Council is encouraging residents to desex their dog/s* by offering a desexing promotion in the 2021/2022 financial year.

Council will pay the 2021/2022 registration charge for a dog* where a signed vet certificate is provided to Council on or before 1 August 2021 indicating that the animal was desexed during the promotional period.

To be eligible for the Dog Desexing Promotion the animal must be desexed between 1 June 2021 and 1 August 2021.

Owners who qualify for payment should complete the below application form and return it to a Somerset Regional Council administration office on or before 1 August 2021.

* The Dog Desexing Program excludes dogs that are a declared dangerous dog, a restricted dog or regulated dog under the Animals Management (Cats and Dogs) Act 2008.
