Introduction

Somerset Regional Council is excited to announce the second round of online engagement for the Kilcoy Streetscape Revitalisation project, which presents the draft master plan for community feedback. Strategically positioned as a gateway to renowned tourist destinations including some of the state's most popular natural assets, Kilcoy has a lot to offer for locals and visitors alike.

This project will define the identity of Kilcoy, building on what is already well loved about the township to enhance its appeal for everyone. The main outcome for this project will be the development of a master plan for the town centre and main streets, along with an exploration for short, medium and long-term actions setting a roadmap for how this future vision can be achieved. More specifically the project will consider things such as pedestrian footpaths; street trees and shade; street furniture and opportunities for public art; entry and wayfinding signage and public gathering spaces.

Our Vision for Kilcoy



- Town map and vertical gateway elements (le: Recycled timber power poles/railway sleepers
- Improvements to William Street service lane including footpath upgrades, street trees and place making
- Raised pedestrian crossings within services lanes
- Buffer planting and vertical trellis elements with creepers to Service Lanes along D'Agular Highway
- Town Green and Central Gateway: 'KILCOY' signage wall and trellis, community notice board, planted mounding, lawn and seating
- Existing Public Toilet and Bus Stop to be retained
- New 45 degree on street parking
- Zebra crossing
- Pedestrian crossing with planted build outs and central refuge (low planting to maintain sight lines)
- Improvements to Mary Street Retail zone including paved verges, street trees build outs and place
- Improvements to Mary Street Residential zone including turf verges, footpaths, street trees build outs and place
- Improvements to Hope Street including turf verges, footpaths, clearer truck parking, pedestrian crossing and refuge, street build outs
- Improvements to Yowie Park including town map, amphitheatre and staggered replacement of shade trees, improved Market layout
- Western Gateway

Improvements to Aston Park including fitness stations, horse trail, learn to ride track / pump track, improved path connections with distance markers, picnic/bbq shelters, seating, lighting, parallel parking, bollards and place activation
