



## Wick Wiper Unit Hire Agreement

### WICK WIPER HIRE CHECKLIST

I have been provided with an induction on the operating controls of the Wick Wiper unit by a Somerset Regional Council competent person.

- I have been advised that petroleum products **MUST NOT** be added for any reason into the spray tank of this equipment.
- I understand that during transport and use of the Wick Wiper unit, I must secure the unit to my vehicle using the tie-down straps supplied with the unit (one supplied).
- Tie-down straps are to be returned with the unit to Somerset Regional Council after hire completion.
- I have been issued with the instruction manual for the Wick Wiper unit. This *Instruction Manual* is to be returned to Somerset Regional Council with the Wick Wiper unit.
- I have been shown the physical location of the various components of the unit as supplied, including the starting procedure, valve operation, and control operation.
- The need to conduct a pre-operational check before any operation of the unit was conducted and I was shown where this pre-operational check is documented on page one of the *Instruction Manual*.
- I have been shown how to fill the spray tank as detailed on page two and three of the *Instruction Manual*.
- I understand that the spray tank must be empty of any chemical / liquid before returning it to Somerset Regional Council.
- The tank must undergo a triple rinse process using water to remove any chemical residues. This triple rinse is to be undertaken on my property.
- The basic operation of the Wick Wiper unit was demonstrated as detailed on page three of the *Instruction Manual* discussed.
- I was shown page five in the *Instruction Manual* where I could source troubleshooting information referring to this unit. Trouble shooting is in some cases provided by Somerset Regional Council on (07) 5424 4000.
- I have been advised to wear PPE as per the Wick Wiper unit *Instruction Manual* and the chemical manufacturer's instructions.
- I have been instructed to follow the manufacturer's instructions for mixing chemicals and for the use within a tank such as that of the Wick Wiper unit.
