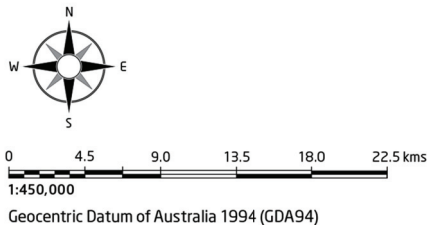


Notes

- Note 1:** Significant Vegetation may comprise:
- Areas of high ecological significance (HES)
 - Areas of general ecological significance (GES)
 - Locally significant vegetation supporting threatened ecosystems and/or habitat for threatened species
 - Land under various tenure
 - Infrastructure easements (e.g. transmission lines, pipelines, road and rail)
- Note 2:** Biodiversity Corridors, defined as State bioregional, subregional and local corridors that may comprise:
- Existing or desirable biodiversity habitat areas essential for maintaining regional or state biodiversity
 - Significant Vegetation
