1. OBJECTIVE

To provide assistance dogs' status to dogs kept in facilities such as Aged Care Centres.

2. BACKGROUND

During recent consultation on changes to the animal management local laws, representations were made regarding the therapeutic value of dogs in facilities such as aged care centres.

3. PURPOSE

The purpose of this policy is to provide guidance to Council officers in ensuring compliance with the animal Management (Cats and Dogs) Act 2009 and Subordinate Local Law 2 (Animal Management).

4. SCOPE

This policy applies throughout the Somerset Regional Council area, but is limited in its application to dogs kept on those properties included in the schedule.

5. POLICY

For the purposes of the Animal Management (Cats and Dogs) Act 2009 and Subordinate local law 2 (Animal Management) a dog left for therapeutic purposes on properties included in the following Schedule shall have the same status as an assistance dog. As such, this policy provides that –

- For the purposes of registration, the fee payable is equivalent to that payable for an assistance dog.
- The dog is not included when calculating the number of dogs kept on the property.
- Such status ceases to exist if the dog is removed from the property.
