

Public Notice: Proposed Interim Amendment to Local Government Infrastructure Plan

Somerset Regional Council is proposing an Interim Amendment to the Somerset Region Local Government Infrastructure Plan.

The Somerset Region Planning Scheme includes a Local Government Infrastructure Plan (LGIP). The LGIP identifies the proposed trunk infrastructure needed to service existing and projected growth across the region. The LGIP ensures trunk infrastructure is delivered in a coordinated, efficient and financially viable manner. The Interim Amendment to the LGIP proposes to review the infrastructure included in the plan.

Public Consultation Period

Public consultation for the "Interim Local Government Infrastructure Plan Amendment" opens **Wednesday**, **15 October 2025** and has been extended, and will now close on **Wednesday**, **26 November 2025**.

Submissions

Any person may make a submission to Council about any aspect of the Interim Amendment to the Local Government Infrastructure Plan during the public consultation period.

A properly made submission must:

- be signed by each person making the submission;
- be received by Council on or before 26 November 2025;
- state the full name and residential or business address of each person making the submission;
- state the grounds of the submission and the facts and circumstances relied on in support of the grounds;
- state a postal or electronic address for service relating to the submission for each person making the submission; and
- be made to Somerset Regional Council.
