SOMERSET REGIONAL COUNCIL - IMPORTANT INFORMATION PERTAINING TO YOUR RATE NOTICE

This notice is produced on the basis of information made available to Council by the State Government and other parties up to and including the date that is 12 working days before the issue date. Notice is hereby given that the above mentioned rates and charges have been made and levied by the Somerset Regional Council, by virtue of the Local Government Act on land described above, for the period stated in this Rate notice (plus overdue rates and charges with interest, if any) and are DUE AND PAYABLE ON THE DATE SHOWN ON THIS NOTICE. Change of ownership fees and bank dishonour fees are not rates and non-payment of these amounts will not result in the loss of rates discount. "Charges raised this financial year" includes rate arrears and applicable interest charges as well as any change of ownership fees, bank dishonour fees or pro rata pensioner rate adjustments due to change of ownership that were levied previously and have not yet been paid. This invoice contains GST of \$0.00.

STATE GOVERNMENT PENSIONER RATE SUBSIDY: Council is required to verify the continuing eligibility of pensioners for the State Government Pensioner Rate Subsidy with Centrelink and other relevant agencies each year. If these agencies report a mismatch between their records and Council's, Council may be required to cease providing the subsidy. You can still apply or reapply if you are a qualifying pensioner with a pensioner concession card and you can meet the ownership and residency requirements of the Scheme. DISCOUNT: Where discount is available, payment must arrive on or before close of business on the due date. Discount is available on the current levy only if ALL rates, arrears and interest are paid in FULL using one of the payment methods.

VALUATIONS AND LAND USE CODES are provided and determined by the Department of Natural Resources and Mines, Manufacturing and Regional and Rural Development. Enquiries regarding the value should be directed to (07) 3330 4343.

IMPLICATIONS OF ALLOWING RATES TO FALL INTO ARREARS: Interest of 12.12% per annum, compounding daily, will accrue on overdue rates 21 days after the due date until the date of receipt of FULL payment. Legal action may be taken by Council including sale of lands in some circumstances.

WASTE MANAGEMENT charges apply to all habitable premises within a defined garbage area, irrespective of the period of occupancy. Council's Waste Management Charge covers costs associated with managing waste in the Somerset Region, including the gap between the Queensland Government levy charged to Council and the rebate received by Council.

- * The Queensland Government Waste Levy for general waste has increased to \$125 per tonne (9% rise compared to 2024/25).
- * Council is required to pay an estimated \$1.2M in waste levy fees to the Queensland Government.
- * Council will receive \$759,539 from the Queensland Government to mitigate the impact of the Waste Levy on households.

EMERGENCY MANAGEMENT LEVY is a State Government charge. All correspondence should be addressed to: Queensland Fire Department, GPO Box 1425, Brisbane QLD 4001.

ADJUSTMENTS TO SERVICE CHARGES MADE WITHOUT ISSUING SUPPLEMENTARY NOTICES: Where in the course of a financial year there are charges to a service, Council may charge for the service based on a percentage or multiple of the actual number of services in order to achieve the correct charge on a subsequent notice without issuing a separate adjustment notice.
